Overview

This program has been created to offer separately the unit *'TDMMH707B Apply weather information when navigating a small vessel within the limits of responsibility of a Master 4'*. This unit may be of interest to mariners wanting to broaden their knowledge about practical meteorology and weather forecasting at sea.

Students will receive a Transcript of Results.

This is not an accredited program.

Students will achieve competency in the national unit appearing in the following table.

This course is suitable to study from a correctional centre.

Vocational outcomes

After successfully completing this program, you will have the ability to forecast and assess the weather for safe voyage planning and decision making.

Entry requirements

OTEN has no special requirements for entry to this program.

Fees

The cost of the program is \$200.

This program is generally open for enrolment at any time of the year, subject to the availability of places.

There are no fee exemptions or concessions.

There are no refunds for TAFE PLUS programs once enrolled, however a substitute delegate may participate. There is no provision for the course fee to be transferred to any other TAFE NSW College or any other TAFE NSW course.

Other associated costs:

There are compulsory residential and/or practical components as part of this program.

This program is suitable for study if you reside permanently outside Australia. However, the cost of the practical assessment outside of these offered by OTEN will have to be met by the candidate.

Duration

OTEN allows you one year to complete this program from the date of your initial enrolment. However, students should aim to complete the program within 6 months.

This program is equal to 12 nominal hours.

Most OTEN students would find that they have to do **extra** hours of study for this program due to the nature of distance education.

Centrelink

Some students may be eligible for financial assistance to study from Centrelink. Applications for assistance are assessed by Centrelink, so you should contact your nearest Centrelink office to discuss your eligibility.

If you receive a Centrelink student payment to study, you are expected to **complete** your program within the **time allocated by Centrelink**. This time may be less than the time OTEN allows. You are also required to show consistent and regular **progress** through your program, and complete units regularly throughout your enrolment. If not, you may incur a Centrelink debt which you will have to repay.

Hardware and software required

There are no particular hardware and software requirements. However, it is extremely desirable to have regular access to the internet so that you can access the OTEN Learner Support web site (OLS) and the many web references provided in your course.

Structure

There is one compulsory unit of competency (unit) in this program.

The program is completed by:

- studying at home at your own pace
- an exam
- attendance at a compulsory practical of three hours duration.
